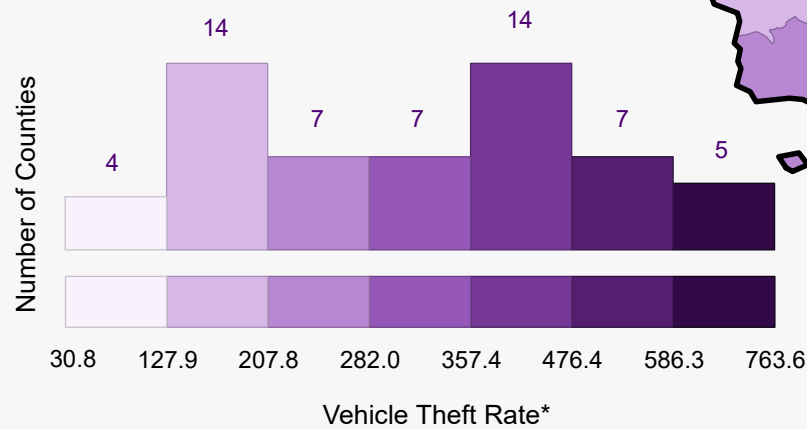
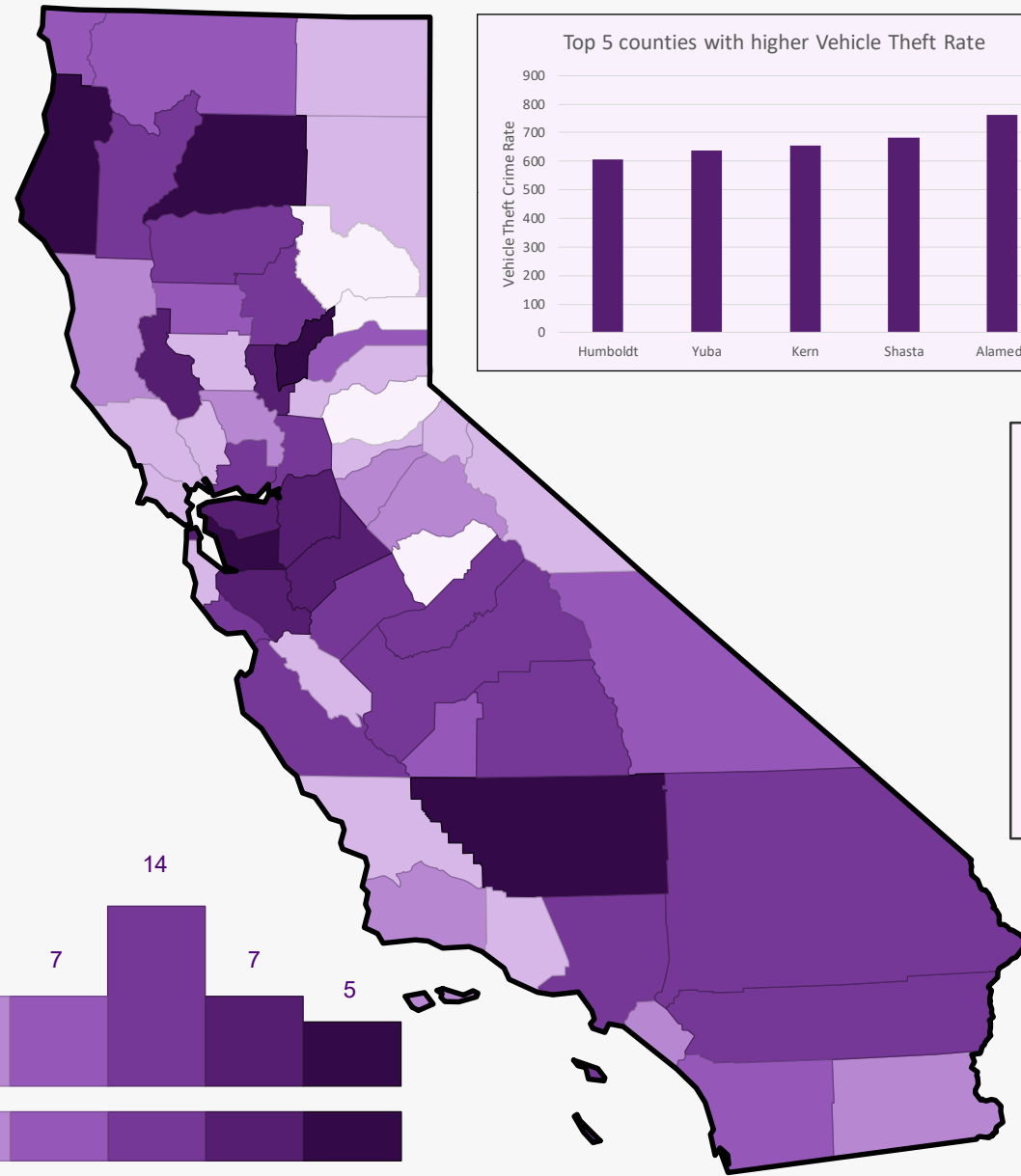

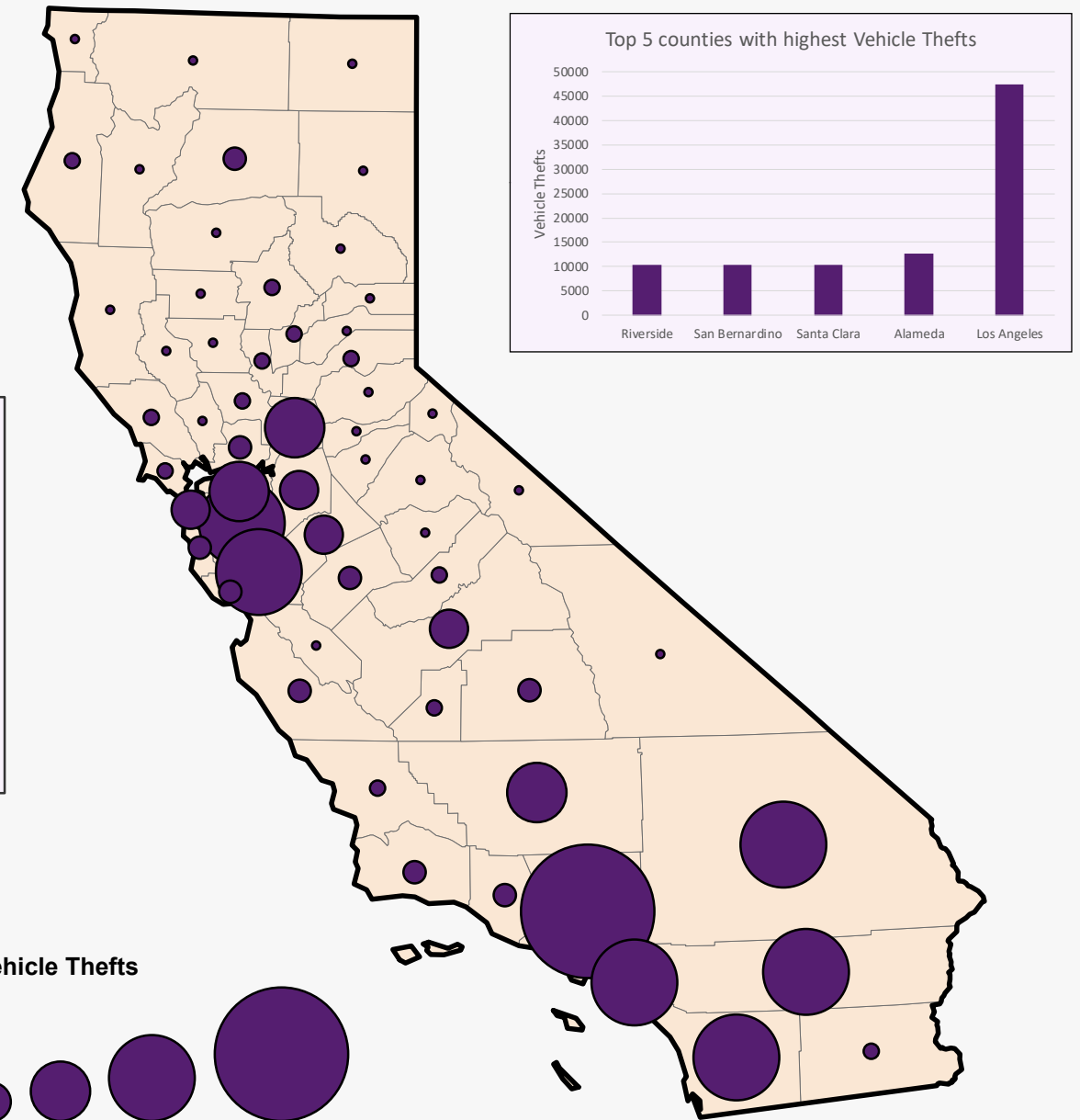

Vehicle Thefts Rate



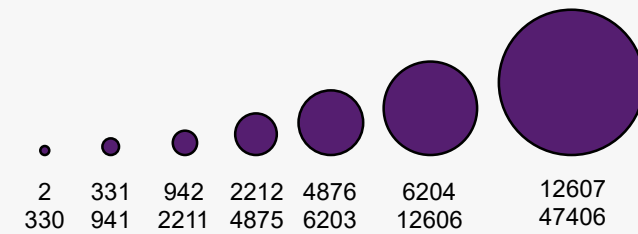

Vehicle Thefts



- In 2017, 175,351 vehicles were stolen, at an estimated total value of approximately \$1.3 billion. This is a 6.2 percent decrease from the 2016 total for vehicle thefts statewide.
- The average rate of theft in 2017 was one vehicle every three minutes.
- The 1998 Honda Civic ranks as the number one stolen vehicle statewide.

Total Number of Vehicle Thefts

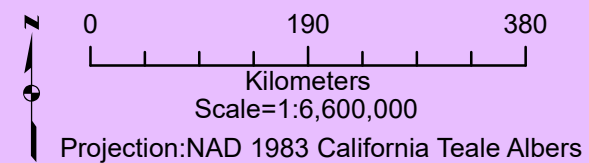
